- **LEARNING:** Learning Process, Learning Theories: Classical Conditioning, Operant condition, Cognitive Theories, Perceptual Learning, Learning and Motivation, Verbal Learning and Motor Learning.
- **PERCEPTION:** Perception process, Perceptual Colour, Depth and line, Perceptual constancy, Role of motivation, Social and cultural factors in Perception Sensory distortion and Sensory deception (illusion, hallucinations).
