
MINUTES


of the Consultative Online Meeting of Deans of Faculties, Principals of Colleges/Polytechnics and other functionaries of the University held on 02.06.2020 at 10:30 am.

The following was unanimously decided: -

1. In view of the fact that AMU is a Residential University having about 16000 students in hostels from all States/Union Territories of India and keeping the health and safety of the students in mind and the prevailing COVID19 situation and danger of spread of COVID19 in hostels due to congestion and difficulty in maintaining social distancing and to avoid a potential serious health crisis on campus, the final semester/term/year Examinations for all Under Graduate (UG) and Post Graduate (PG) programmes along with arrear/backlog courses of previous semester/term/year shall be held in Online, Open Book Examination mode.
2. All the students are advised to make prior arrangements for Online Examination facilities at their respective places of residence.
3. Further details of the Online Examinations including dates will be communicated by the Office of the Controller of Examination, but Online Examination are likely to be held only after 10.07.2020. Online Examinations for backlog/arrear papers may be held from 05.07.2020 to 10.07.2020.
4. Summer vacations for teachers will be from **15.06.2020 to 30.06.2020**. The teachers before proceeding on vacations should submit the sessional marks and the question paper of the course which they are teaching including backlog/arrear papers. The concerned Dean and Chairperson should ensure this. The cooperation of all teachers is required in this matter.
5. As is the practice, during vacation, the dining halls will also close from 15.06.2020 and all remaining students are advised to make arrangements for their travel to their home towns in a safe and secure manner. University administration will also help them in every way possible. If any student is unable to go for any genuine reasons, University Administration will help in facilitating dining facilities.

6. Due to COVID19 Pandemic university will not re-open for students before **1st August, 2020** and keeping in view the health and safety of students no fresh entry will be given to students in university hostels before 1st August, 2020 and students should not make any travel arrangements to come to the university. Further guidance will be given around 15th July, 2020 as per the COVID19 situation.
